RCIA (Adapted for Children age 7 -14) & RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults – age 15 and above)

Everyone is invited to journey with our RCIA candidates in learning more about Catholic Faith. Catechesis is one of the pastoral priorities identified by our parish. The sessions are held on Monday evenings in the St. Agnes Hall. The sessions run from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Our final session is on **April 7th, 2025**. The topic will be “Human Dignity”.
