## **SACRAMENTS**

### **RCIA (Adapted for Children age 7 -14) & RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults – age 15 and above)**

Everyone is invited to journey with our RCIA candidates in learning more about Catholic Faith. Catechesis is one of the pastoral priorities identified by our parish. The sessions are held on Monday evenings in the St. Agnes Hall. The sessions run from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Our next session is on **Monday, January 13, 2025**. The topic will be “The Eucharist.”

**MARRIAGE:** Because the church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of **six months notice prior to the intended date of their wedding**. Normally the parish boundaries determine in which parish marriage planning should take place.

**FUNERAL:** Family or designated person by the family should contact the Parish Office for funeral arrangements with the parish priest.

### **COLLECTION IN HONOUR OF ST. AGNES**

Next **Sunday, January 19**, we celebrate the feast of Saint Agnes. There will be a potluck lunch after the Noon mass at Saint Agnes Church. Potluck dishes can be dropped off in the basement kitchen before mass. Agnes is the patron saint of girls, chastity, virgins, and victims of sexual abuse. So, we are honouring her by collecting donations for Gianna Centre, a facility run by Catholic Social Services to support vulnerable pregnant women. Gianna Centre asks for: **Baby wipes / 0-3 and 3-6 month clothes (new or gently used), especially socks, sleepers, diaper shirts, and boys' clothes in general / soothers / baby shampoo and lotion / baby face cloths / vitamin D drops / swaddles and receiving blankets / toothpaste / shampoo and conditioner / deodorant / lotion**. Please place donations in the box by the statue of St. Agnes in the sanctuary.
